

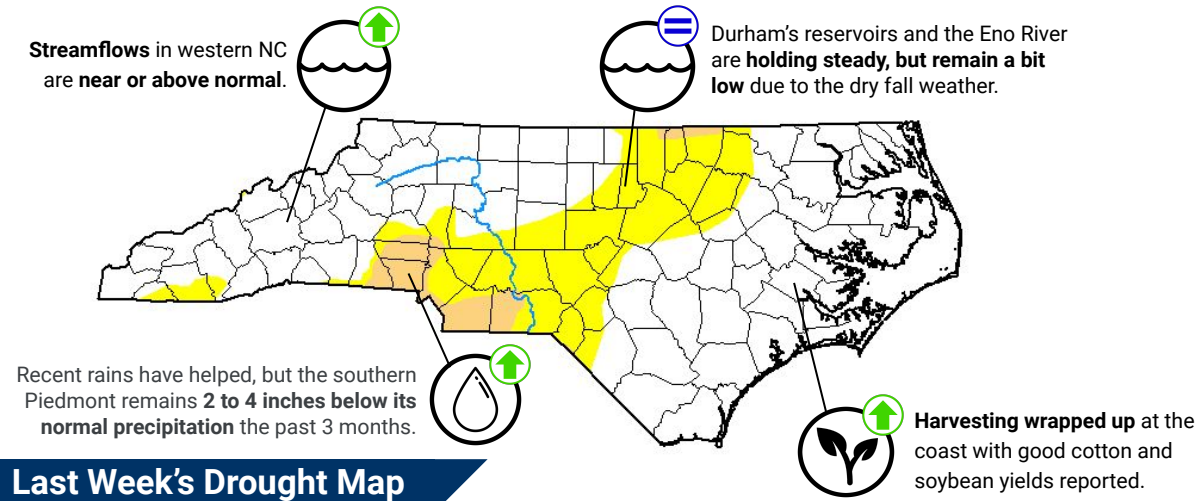
North Carolina Drought Update

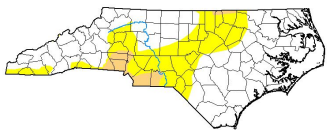


What's Changed? Abnormally Dry conditions are on the decline in the Mountains, which have **almost completely recovered** back to normal conditions after our early fall flash drought.

What's New? Our recent cold weather has brought the first fall freeze and an **end to the growing season** across the state.

What's Next? A coastal low should bring **up to 1.5 inches of rain** in eastern North Carolina on Friday and Saturday. Inland areas look to be drier this week.
